Reporting Officer's Summary of Offense/Incident:

*Police and firefighters were dispatched to the old church atop the hill neighboring Hayseed's (W) property with report of a fire and children trapped inside the building. Upon arrival, two teenage boys, Ponyboy Curtis, 14, and Johnny Cade, 16, were inside the church, pushing five children out a window on the eastern side of the building. A third teenager, Dallas Winston, 17, was on the exterior of the window receiving the children and pulling them to safety.*

*Jerry Wood (W), one of the children's teachers, reported that the teens ran to the fire, heedless of their own safety. Winston and Curtis sustained moderate injuries; Cade was severely injured and had to be pulled from the flames by emergency personnel. All were transported to the hospital via ambulance. None could be interviewed today. The cause of the fire remains unknown, but arson is not suspected.*
